I try to engage groups that come to the funeral home and asked what they thought funerals were for. I was amazed by their simple yet insightful answers. Offering B: Funeral service only

Services of funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to funeral home within 25 miles, embalming, other preparations of the body, use of facilities for funeral ceremony or service in other facility, funeral coach, committal or other disposition service, acknowledgement cards, color prayer folders or holy card w/ picture and color register book, memorial video (up to 30 pictures). Itemized Select.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff.....\$1,975.00*

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notice; shelter of remains; and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., cemetery, crematory, vault companies and others as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, parking lot and grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping, and secretarial and administrative expenses.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for packaged services, direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming.....\$695.00*

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Additional Use of Facility, Staff and Equipment Fees:

A. Visitation at the Funeral Home

Our services will include visitation setup, use of visitation room, placement of encased remains, display of floral arrangements, parking lot assistance, and supervision, memorial DVD and attendance during the visitation.

Our services include coordinating the funeral arrangements, supervision of funeral, staff to attend the funeral ceremony, supervision of committal or other disposition service, Memorial DVD and setup and use of facilities for funeral ceremony.

Our services include coordinating the funeral arrangement, supervision of committal or other disposition service, and equipment and additional staff necessary to conduct funeral at other facility.

Our services include coordinating the memorial service, supervision of the memorial service, staff to attend memorial service, and setup and use of facilities for memorial service.

E. Memorial Service at Other Facility\$395.00

Our services include coordinating the memorial service, supervision of the memorial service and additional staff necessary to conduct memorial service at other facility.

Our services include coordinating the funeral arrangement at graveside, supervision of the graveside service, and equipment and staff necessary to conduct the graveside service.

Forwarding Remains to Another Funeral Firm

This charge includes removal of remains, basic services of staff, embalming, necessary authorizations and local transportation to airport. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding of the body.

Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home.....\$1,425.00

This charge includes pickup of remains, transportation of remains to cemetery and basic services of staff. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies.

Immediate Burial\$2,440.00

The charge for immediate burial includes removal of remains, local transportation to the cemetery, necessary authorizations and basic services of staff. This charge does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to burial.

- A. Immediate burial with casket provided by purchaser\$2,440.00
- B. Immediate burial with gray cloth covered soft fiberboard casket selected from our funeral home.....\$2929.00
- C. Immediate burial with casket selected from our funeral home (in addition to the cost of the casket)..... \$2,440.00

Direct Cremation\$1,975.00

The charge for a direct cremation includes removal of remains, local transportation to crematory necessary authorizations, and basic services of the staff. This charge does include the crematory fee but does not include the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to the cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are unfinished wood boxes and fiberboard boxes and at the discretion of the funeral director may be airline shipping containers previously used for human remains that have been thoroughly refurbished.
